



## STATE REPRESENTATIVE TEAM SELECTION CRITERIA

**State Representative Team Qualifying Events** – State Double Barrel, State Single Barrel, State Points Score and State Postal Teams score.

- Open Team           50T Points Score
- Section Teams       25T Points Score

**Open Team** – The top five (5) scorers from the total field will form the open team which may include Women, Junior's and Veterans. All that qualify regardless of age or sex will take their place in the Open team for the State Representative Team.

**SECTION TEAMS WILL BE SELECTED IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER AS DETAILED BELOW:**

**Junior Team** – will be selected first and will comprise the three (3) highest scoring juniors not already qualified in the open team, regardless of sex.

**Women's Team** – will be selected second and comprise the three (3) highest scoring women not already qualified in a team.

**Veterans Team** – will be selected third and comprise the three (3) highest scoring veterans not already qualified in a team regardless of sex.

**Note** – Any Junior's, Women and Veterans that qualified for the Open Team, the first 25T Points Score of the 50T State Postal Team Points Score event will count towards the Section Teams.

**Ties** – In the event of a tie for fifth place in the Open Team, or third place in the Section Teams, to be shot off as points score, miss (target or point) and out.

**Reserves** – Three reserves will be named for all teams in the order of qualification. This may mean that section team members may be named as reserves in other teams and creates the possibility that they may have to "move up" to another team.

Reserve Ties – Will be decided by counting back starting with the scores of the State Postal Teams event with the last target miss used to eliminate. If this does not get a result the same process will be applied to the State Points Score, then the State Single Barrel and then the State Double Barrel scores. If this does not get a result the elimination will continue on the event conducted prior to the State Double Barrel and so on until a result is achieved.

**Juniors** – On selecting the State Representative Junior Team for the Nationals the following year, please ensure that they do not age out prior to the event (must be under 18 at time of Nationals). If so, the next qualified Junior will take that spot. Reserves are to be promoted as per procedure above.

#### **TEAM HIGHGUNS:**

The team high gun is the best score from the State Postal Team shoot (Open – 50T Point Score and Sections – 25T Point Score). A team high gun is awarded in all sections.

Shooters are only eligible for the team high gun in the team they competed for the State Postal Team event. For example, a junior who shot in the open team is only eligible for the open team high gun.

In the event of a tie, team high guns will be shot off as points, miss (target or point) and out.

#### **QUEENSLAND CHAMPION:**

Shooter with the best score from the State Representative Team qualifying events – Total of 400 points/targets.
